The occupations with the most employees in Michigan provide very few middle class jobs.

50% of Michigan's payroll jobs are in just five large occupational categories -and the majority of jobs in those categories don't pay a middle class wage.

Six in 10 payroll jobs in Michigan pay less than what it takes for a family of three to be middle class.



All data from 2019's pre-pandemic economy. We adopted a methodology developed by the Pew Research Center, adjusted for cost-of-living in Michigan, to establish our standards for a family of three to just enter the middle class (\$47,026) and to join the upper middle class (\$70,539).
